

# **INITIATIVE & PROJECT IDEAS**

#### Neighborhood Transportation Pledge

Research different pledge programs that promote improvinga air quality by reducing weekly trips. Set up a prize system to incentivize participation.

#### Vehicle Maintenance Educational Workshop

Learn to improve efficiency and reduce emissions.

#### Bike to Work Day

Plan a group bike ride or host a station for riders on Bike to Work Day.

#### Carpool Network

Promote regional carpooling programs or create one for the neighborhood.

#### Alternative Transportation Map and Guide

Develop a resource for existing and new residents in the neighborhood highlighting bike, pedestrian, vehicle sharing and other features.

#### Carbon Footprint Challenge

Host a workshop with the City to learn how to reduce your carbon footprint.

#### Anti-Idling Pledge

Establish an anti-idling pledge in your community to reduce emissions and increase air quality.

#### Fireplace Replacement

Reduce the number of wood-burning fireplaces in use in your neighborhood by educating neighbors about the impact they have on air quality.

#### Tree Planting

Hold events to plant trees in yards or along the street to improve air quality.

#### **Electric Lawn Equipment**

Promote the use of electric lawn equipment. Research and communicate different purchasing options with the community.


#### In-home Air Quality Workshop

# **INITIATIVE & PROJECT IDEAS**

#### Indoor & Outdoor Water Audits

Conserve water resources and

improve water quality.

Partner with Larimer County Conservation Corps for Home Efficiency Assessments, and schedule sprinkler audits with Fort Collins Utilities.

#### Water Conservation Fair

Give neighbors the opportunity to learn about water-wise products and services to reduce water use, discover rebates available from Fort Collins Utilities and talk with local businesses about water use reduction and conservation services. *fcgov.com/save-water* 

#### <u>Garden in a Box</u>

GOAL

Replace under-utilized areas of grass with colorful, low-water plants, professionally designed for a space. *fcgov.com/GIAB* 

#### Neighborhood Mulch Day

Call a local arborist or landscape supply company to bring a pile of wood mulch to your neighborhood for a day of mulching.

#### Leaky Faucet Repair Team

Build a team of neighborhood volunteers who can be contacted to repair leaky faucets and toilets.

#### Stream Bank and Adopt-a-Ditch Projects

Protect vegetation and prevent erosion around neighborhood waterways; commit to regular cleanup days of local waterways.

#### Rain Barrel Workshop

Rain barrels are now legal in Colorado! Hold a workshop to inform residents of what they need to know for installing rain barrels in their yards.

#### Fertilizer and Pesticide Reduction Campaign

Learn about the impacts of chemicals on water quality and create a pledge to reduce chemicals

#### **Stormwater Education**

Educate neighbors on stormwater drainage and quality.

#### **Regional Water-wise Garden Tours**

Learn about water-wise landscaping and tour local xeriscape gardens. *fcgov.com/xeriscape* 

#### Water Conservation Best Practices Pledge

Add materials to neighborhood soil to improve its capacity.


#### Habitat Tree Inventory

#### Household Hazardous Material Recycling

Organize a special collection to learn about the types of hazardous materials that can be recycled and where to take them.

#### **Green Purchasing Guide**

Create a guide for purchasing environmentally friendly household cleaners and other products.

#### Curbside Recycling Sign-up

Host an information workshop in partnership with the City about what items can and cannot be recycled. Then, encourage curbside recycling by residents as part of their trash service.

#### Noxious Weed Removal

Hold a workshop to educate neighborhoods on how to remove noxious weeds and then spend a day removing these threatening plants.

and Leaf Recycling Host a workshop on backyard composting and a fall leaf cleanup.

#### Alternative Pest Control

Learn how to use horticultural oils to keep plants safe while reducing effects on beneficial insects.

# **INITIATIVE & PROJECT IDEAS**

#### **Develop a Community Outreach Plan**

A community outreach plan should include all possible outlets of communication to the neighborhood such as social media, phone and email trees, mailing lists, webpages, etc. Identify which resources are multilingual.

#### **Community Asset Inventory**

Create an inventory of all organizations, schools and nonprofits in the neighborhood to explore potential partnerships.

#### Community Clubs

Create a group that meets regularly to do activities such as exercise or cleanup trash in the neighborhood.

#### Walkability Analysis

Identify missing sidewalk links and other barriers.

#### **Community Charity Events**

Host food, coat, school supply, or other charitable drives.

#### **Helping Hands Network**

Establish a network of volunteers to assist with home maintenance.
