The Sustainable Neighborhoods program gives residents the opportunity to become active partners in making Lakewood a vibrant and sustainable community. Neighborhoods participating in this unique certification program use guidance from the City staff to organize workshops, projects and events that enhance the livability of their neighborhood and reduce resident’s ecological footprint.

Participating neighborhoods earn program credits for projects and initiatives and, depending on the number of credits earned in a given year, may receive City designation as an “**Outstanding Sustainable Neighborhood**,” earning custom signage for the neighborhood.

This past spring, the Southern Gables neighborhood applied to and was accepted into City of Lakewood’s Sustainable Neighborhoods Program. The program provides Southern Gables with resources and support to work on neighborhood projects and initiatives that enhance sustainability in the program’s five goal areas: energy, air, water, land, and people.

On May 31, 2013, residents gathered at the Green Gables Elementary School for a kickoff workshop where we learned about the program and discussed ideas for projects. Residents also designed a neighborhood survey soliciting ideas and gauging interest on a variety of sustainability-related topics.

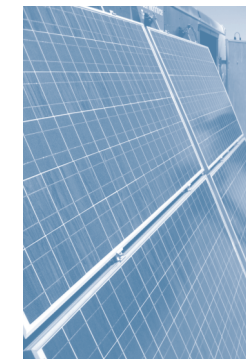
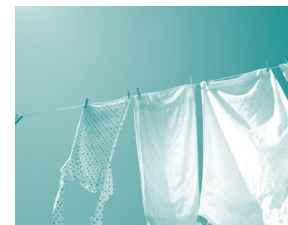
